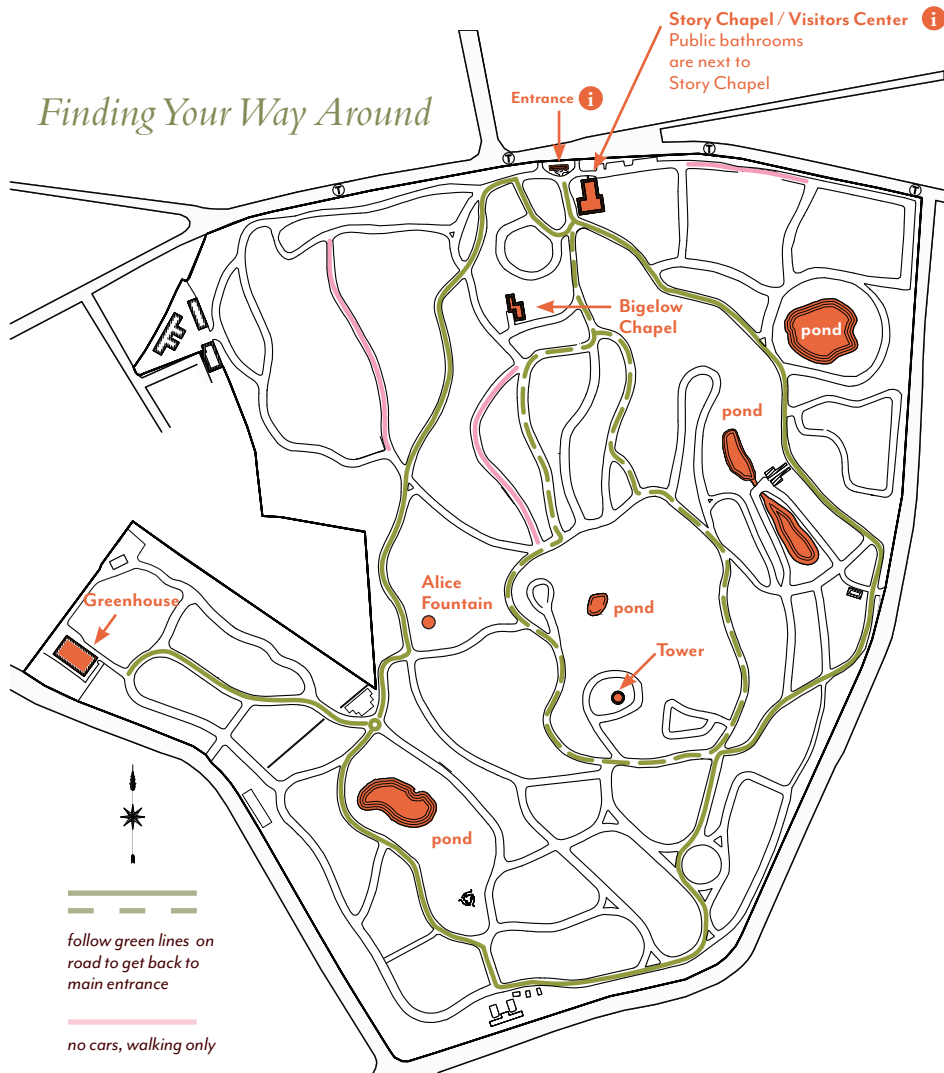


## Finding Your Way Around
